Call for Applications for 6-Months Certificate Programme in Community Health for Nurses under Meghalaya National Health Mission:-

National Health Mission, Meghalaya invites candidates who are willing and enthusiastic to serve the community by bringing health care services to the doorsteps of the community to apply for **6-Months Certificate Program in Community Health for Nurses**. This course is part of an initiative under the National Health Mission to strengthen Sub-Centres as Health & Wellness Centres (H&WCs) for improved implementation of public health programmes and to enable comprehensive primary health care service delivery, including disease prevention and health promotion. Candidates who successfully complete this course will be posted at these Sub Centres as Community Health Officers (CHOs) to lead a primary health care team consisting of frontline workers such as the female health workers (ANMs), male health worker (MPW), and ASHAs.

The programme will be implemented through the Indira Gandhi National Open University (IGNOU). The duration of the course will be of 6 months with two academic sessions in 1st July & 1st January each year.

Essential Criteria:

- General Nursing and Midwifery (GNM) RNRM from a recognized Institute/Bachelor of Science in Nursing from a recognised Institute/University.
- Less than 35 years of age; however, less than 40 years for the SCs and STs.

Desirable Criteria:

- Proficiency in regional/local language and dialect.
- At least 2 years of work experience in the Public Health system, preferably at the Primary/Community Health Centre level.

No. of seats:

- 25 seats at Garo Hills

National Health Mission, Meghalaya shall provide support for boarding and lodging allowance; IGNOU fees; transport for practicum, and other training related costs. Apart from this, candidates will continue to receive their salary/compensation during the training period.

After successful completion of the course, the successful candidates will be posted at the identified Sub Centres as Health & Wellness Nurse and will receive additional increment or higher remuneration for working as Health & Wellness Nurse.

Eligible and interested candidates can submit their applications on or before **4:00pm of the 20th July 2021** by mandatorily filling the Google form as per link mentioned below:

1. Candidate should use only Gmail account for registration in the google form.
2. Candidates should apply only once using the google form and upload the supporting scanned documents in a **single PDF file (the PDF should be renamed by first and last name of the applicant and its total size should be less than 1 MB)**.
3. When uploading, select pdf file from your local device/drive.
4. All applications will be subjected to a screening process constituted for the purpose.
5. Shortlisted candidates will have to undergo a written examination.
6. All relevant Certificates Testimonials etc. (IN ORIGINAL) to be produced at the time of interview if shortlisted.
7. The undersigned reserves the right to reject any/all applications without assigning any reason thereof.
8. The schedule of written test/interview to shortlisted candidates will be published in the website and in the office notice Board. All applicants are advised to visit the website or the office Notice Board accordingly. No separate individual call letter for written test/interview will be sent.
9. The written test and interview will be held in Tura/Shillong.
10. No TA/DA will be paid to the applicants for attending the interview.
